



Lineside Railway Buildings

- These are representative of small stations dotted along the early western railways. As you will see the passenger accommodation has a slightly raised platform in front and the adjoining goods shed has a higher loading platform.
- Make up both bases using parts cut from No. 70 castings.
- Make up the buildings as shown. Note that the door of the Goods Shed is made from lapboard. It can be glued open or shut.
- 3. Make up roof panels. Chamfer top edges so that they meet flush and also chamfer all other edges so that they appear thinner.
- 4. Glue platforms in place level with the top of the bases. Cut the supports to the appropriate height.
- Paint to represent well weathered logs and glue window acetate in place.
