



#173-Ch-1 p-3 Chalet (Variation of log cabin)

This shows you the small log cabin described in the instruction sheet can be easily made to represent a chalet.

- 1. Construct the main walls together with the eaves.
- 2. Glue castings 74 back to back and glue at corners to represent log extensions.
- 3. Make the shutters by trimming the links from castings 85 or 88 and cutting to length. Chamfer all back edges before glueing in place.
- 4. Make up roof panels. Chamfer the top edges so they fit together and chamfer all other edges so they appear thinner.
- 5. Paint to represent single logs and glue acetate windows in place.
