



REGENCY HOUSE

- 1. This has four storeys and each is constructed using the same method you used to make the small cottage (note that the front and back of each storey is identical).
- 2. Glue the four storeys one on top of the other.
- 3. Glue the eave panels in place.
- 4. Before proceeding further, paint the four storeys and then add the plastic windows.
- 5. Make up roof panels and glue in place (as shown in the small cottage plans). Finish off with coping (7) noting that the centre piece should be cut to the required length. The roof can now be painted.
- 6. Glue castings 10 at the corner joints between the second and third and fourth storeys. Between these glue in place castings 11 noting they will

have to be cut to fit. (See illustration on front of box).

STEPS

Take 5 x No. 1 castings and cut to the sizes shown. Cut and trim 2L and 2R as shown. Glue the 5 x No. 1 castings together to form steps and glue this assembly between 2L and 2R. Repeat for steps at back of building.

STRENGTHENING

When building is complete, triangular pieces can be glued inside at the corners to strengthen. (This could be done while building, but if so they could get in the way when putting the plastic windows in place).
